## PSV'S REFRIGERATED VAN SHINES AT INDIA COLD CHAIN SHOW 2017



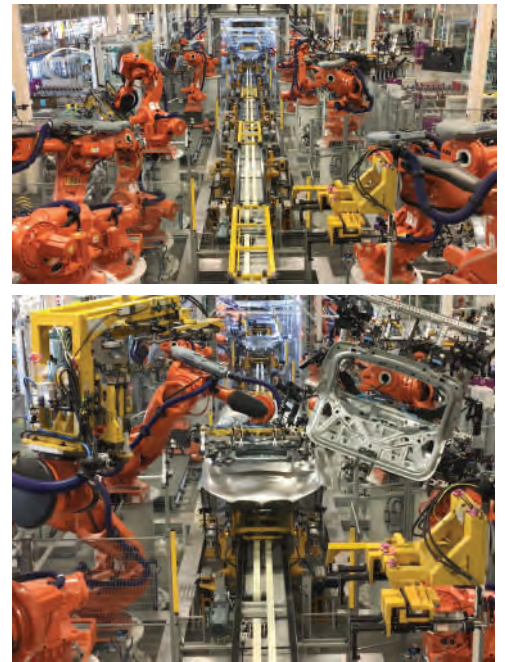
